Come discover how we are building healthcare's future right here in Hamilton.

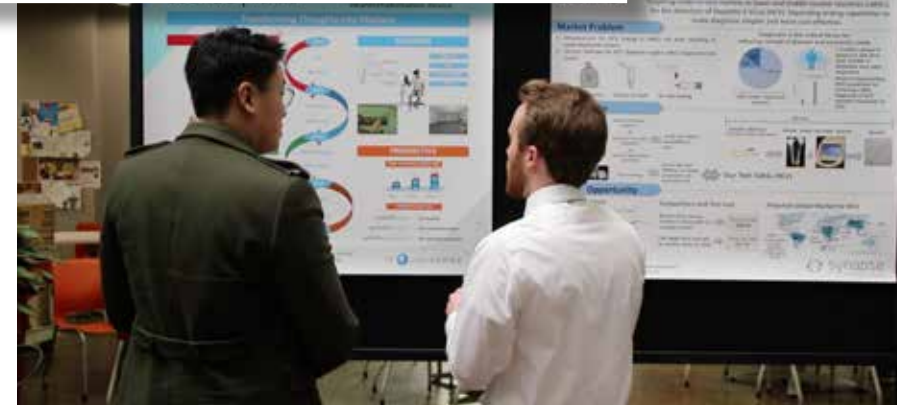

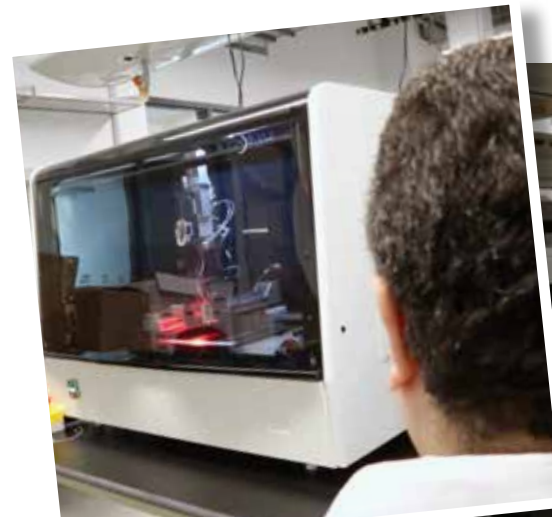
